FRASER ISLAND Season 5, Ep 6 and 7



TRACK NOTES:

Fraser Island is one of Australia's must-see touring and 4WDing destinations. From a quick weekender up to a fortnight epic, there's heaps to see and do. The beach run takes in some of Fraser Island's most iconic attractions, including the Pinnacles, Eli Creek and the Maheno Wrecks, while the inland tracks will bring you to the picturesque lakes and old growth forest.

On this trip, we caught the ferry from River Heads, near Hervey Bay, across to Kingfisher Bay, rather than the traditional Inskp Point barge. From Kingfisher Bay we took the inland tracks across to the Eastern Beach for the run up the beach, past the Maheno, Eli Creek, and the Cathedrals, up to Sandy Cape.

DISTANCE: 100-400km (depending on how long you're there for, and where you go)

NEARBY TRACKS: Cooloola National Park, Stradbroke Island, Moreton

Island

NEAREST TOWN: Inskip, Hervey Bay
